<b>Abstract</b>	<p>The Maryland Association for Family and Community Education Quilt Documentation Project Records, 1988 to 1993 (bulk 1988-1990), consist of 6.8 linear feet of 35-mm color slides and survey forms documenting approximately 2,400 quilts made in Maryland between 1634 and 1934 and examined between 1988 and 1991 by volunteers throughout the state. Slides, identified only by number, may relate to two exhibitions held in 1990, or to another outgrowth of the project, <i>A Maryland Album: Quiltmaking Traditions, 1634-1934</i> by Gloria Seaman Allen (Nashville: Rutledge Hill Press, 1995). The majority of the collection consists of survey forms with detailed information about each quilt and, when known, the makers. Many survey forms are accompanied by color photographs.</p>

## Historical Information

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Maryland Association for Family and Community Education is the regional affiliate the Cooperative Extension Service, established by the Smith-Lever Act in 1914 to supplement the work of land-grant colleges by providing practical education – mostly in the form of home economics – that served the needs of families and communities. As society changed, so did the organization and the skills it taught. Women enjoyed the opportunity to socialize and by 1936 there were local clubs nationwide, some of which focused on specific interests or skills. That year, representatives from clubs in several states organized the National Home Demonstration Council, a non-profit, volunteer led organization dedicated to improving quality of life through community service and by educating communities about health, farm and home management. The Maryland Home Demonstration Club was formed in 1938. Over time, the main organization was known as the National Extension Homemakers Council, later becoming the Association for Family and Community Education, with local affiliates adjusting their names, as well.

In 1983, MAFCE (at that time still the Maryland Extension Homemakers Club) decided to produce a quilt to celebrate its 50th anniversary. Each affiliated group in the state was asked to contribute a square featuring a local church, and the finished quilt was displayed at various locations throughout Maryland. Classes about quilt conservation were offered and MAFCE began to consider documenting Maryland quilts as a way to study social and cultural traditions. As a fundraiser for the anticipated project, MAFCE members made a Postage Stamp pattern quilt. The quilt was shown throughout the state and raffle tickets were sold. With funds from the raffle, MAFCE began applying for grants in order to document quilts, an important part of Maryland's heritage. Documentation standards were devised and volunteers trained to examine, describe, and photograph quilts. Sites and dates were publicized, and from 1988 to 1991 around 2,400 quilts were examined and recorded. In 1990, MAFCE presented two quilt shows, "A Stitch in Time" (September 8-9, 1990), Maryland State Fairgrounds, and "Threads of History" (July 13-20, 1990), Maryland 4-H Foundation, College Park, MD. Subsequently, MAFCE organized annual displays of documented quilts at the Maryland State House. Also in 1990, plans and fundraising began for a book to share some of the quilts and stories discovered by the MAFCE Quilt Documentation Project. *A Maryland Album: Quilting Traditions, 1634-1934* by Gloria Seaman Allen was published in 1995.

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## Scope and Contents

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The MAFCE Quilt Documentation Project Records, 1988-1993 (bulk 1990-1988) consist of 6.8 linear feet of 35-mm color slides, and survey forms. Volunteers in every county of Maryland conducted surveys of approximately 2,400 quilts made in Maryland between 1634 and 1934. They collected detailed information about each quilt's physical characteristics, materials and techniques employed. Although color photographs accompany the majority of survey forms, the amount of photo documentation varies

widely from one county to another. Survey forms indicate how and where the current owners acquired their quilts and biographical information about the quilts' makers is included when known.

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The collection is arranged into two series: 1. Slides 2. Survey Forms. Each series retains its original order.

These 35-mm color slides may have been used for presentations publicizing the Quilt Documentation Project's two 1990 exhibitions, subsequent small, annual quilt shows at the Maryland State House, or related to fundraising for *A Maryland Album: Quilting Traditions, 1634-1934*, a book by Gloria Seaman Allen (1995) that shares some quilts and stories discovered by the MAFCE Quilt Documentation Project. **Survey Forms.****Scope and Contents**

Survey forms contain as much detailed information about the quilts, their owners, and makers as could be gleaned through examining each quilt and interviewing the current owner. The amount and usefulness of the data collected varies widely. Most forms are accompanied by color photographs with the amount of photo documentation varying greatly from one county to another. Forms are comprised of several sections with prompts or multiple choice answers provided where possible.

**"Quilt History"**

(when made, where, age of quiltmaker, source of fabric, why was it made; stories, customs, traditions, associated with it; repairs or restoration, exhibition history, awards received, publication details, how and by whom stored)

**"Ownership History/Provenance"**

(how did present owner acquire it; previous owners, addresses and dates of ownership)

**"Quiltmaker's History"**

(maker's name(s), birth date and place, marriage date and place; spouse's name, birth date and place, death date and place, burial place, occupation(s); where did quiltmaker live, dates, occupation(s), death date and place, burial place; parents' names, birth and death dates, where did they live, ancestry of quiltmaker's family; what church did quiltmaker attend, describe any participation in church quilting activities; education of quiltmaker, rural or urban environment during childhood; if photographs of quiltmaker, how to obtain copies; names and addresses of children with dates and place of birth; availability of written records relating to quiltmaker and family; details of patterns she designed; fabric sources; names and addresses of owners of other quilts by same person)

**"Quilt Documentation"**

(ID Number, name of documenter, date, location; quilt pattern, size, style, how sewn, set, borders, binding with colors noted; edges; quilting type, stitch size, thread color and fiber; batting, backing; condition; other significant features)

Also included with survey forms are a small number of reproduction/publication permission and insurance forms relating to quilt exhibitions (1990) and reproduction of quilts being considered for *A Maryland Album* (1993) published in 1995.
